You've probably seen it before, the dreaded check engine light on your car. How do you respond when you see it? Do you ignore it? Do you make plans to take your car to the shop in the next several days or do you have your car checked out immediately? We are all different and sometimes, based on prior experience with that dreaded light, we may panic or just blow it off. Recently, our car had the nerve to shine that dreaded light on the dashboard. Sometimes cars will give you a little more information on what the issue is other than just an engine light. The car had a message about the Evaporative Emission Control system. After taking the car to a shop, they called me back to let me know there was a hole in the gas tank, and it looks like "rodent" was chewing on it.

As much as I hate to see the engine light and have nightmares about how much it's going to cost, I'm glad the sensor was built into the car. Speaking of sensors, God gives our physical bodies warning signs to help notify us of health issues. Sometimes, computers will give us warning signs that there is a problem. He also gives us sensors and warnings that something in our spiritual life is missing.

For cars, we can look up the error code or take it to a shop. For our bodies, we can go to a medical professional, but what do we do for spiritual concerns? I hope we go to God's word! Similar to a car or the physical body, we don't just go to the shop or the doctor when things are wrong, but we should be keeping our spiritual life fed with the Word of God. Too many people across the world have never heard the Good News about Jesus Christ. Paul tells us in Romans 10:14, "How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And

how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard?"
